

## Modals: Have To

**FORM:**

I have to go	We have to go
You have to go	You have to go
She has to go	They have to go
He has to go	
It has to go	

**USE:**

Use “**have to**” plus the un-conjugated verb to show that something is important, very important, necessary, obligatory or that it must be true.

**NOTE:** “Have” is conjugated here according to the regular verb rules.  
The main verb is always in the base (un-conjugated) form.

**EXAMPLES:**

*I have to go home now.*  
*You have to pay your phone bill.*  
*You have to arrive on time at work.*  
*This is crazy. He has to be an idiot to do this!*
