

## Prepositions: At, To, From, With, In, On

**FORM:** AT / TO / FROM / WITH / IN / ON

**USE:** “At” indicates a lack of movement.  
“To” introduces a destination when the intention of the subject is neutral or positive.  
“From” introduces the starting point of a movement.  
“With” indicates many things; using, accompanying, possessing, concerning, characterizing.  
“In” is used to place something into an object with a top, bottom, and sides.  
“On” is touching an object.

**EXAMPLES:** *Karen arrived at the office at 7:30 am.*  
*He went to the pub.*  
*Every morning he walks from his house to the school.*  
*Joe comes to school with his lunch.*  
*The jacket is in the room.*  
*Don't stand on the table.*
