## **Other Hypothetical Forms: Wish versus Hope**

Wish Wish indicates that the speaker wants reality to be the opposite of what it is. To express wishes about the **future or present**, the past tense is used for the main verb. To express wishes about the **past**, the past perfect is used for the main verb. "Were" is used for singular and plural subjects when the main verb is "be". "That" is optional after wish.

I wish (that) Mary were coming to the party. (Reality: She is not coming to the party.)
They wish (that) their apartment had more space. (Reality: They don't have more space.)
Colleen wishes she had studied for the test. (Reality: She didn't study.)
I wish they had come to my wedding. (Reality: They didn't come.)

**Hope** is used to express a desired result or outcome. This outcome is <u>possible</u>. To express hopes about the present, the present tense is used. To express future hopes, the present or future tense is used. *Hope* can be followed by a noun, pronoun or infinitive. "*That*" is optional after *hope*.

*I <u>hope</u> (that) you <u>like</u> the food I cooked.* (desired outcome for the present) *I <u>hope</u> (that) you <u>had</u> a good vacation.* (desired outcome for past event) *Sam <u>hopes</u> the weather <u>is (will be)</u> nice for his pool party.* (desired outcome for the future)

*They <u>hoped</u> the teacher <u>would like</u> the gift.* (desired outcome in the past) *Dan <u>hoped</u> to retire by the time he <u>was</u> 65. (desired outcome in the past)*
