## **Gerunds:** After Prepositions

Gerunds are frequently used after prepositions, as the object of the preposition.

• Gerunds can follow just a preposition as in: Before <u>calling</u> her mother, Marie checked the details of her flight arrival time.

• Or they can follow a verb and a preposition: *The board approved of <u>hiring</u> Michael J. Fox as the company spokesperson.* 

• Or they can follow an adjective and a preposition: *The child was afraid of <u>being</u> alone in the dark.*
