The Subjunctive: Adjectives that Use the Subjunctive

FORM:	The adjectives <i>essential, imperative, important, critical, vital, and necessary</i> can be followed in sentences by either infinitives or present subjunctive verbs.
USE:	These sentence forms are used in formal English to describe important things.
EXAMPLES:	You have to be on time tomorrow. It is essential. It is essential <u>to be</u> on time tomorrow. (infinitive) It is essential that you <u>be</u> on time tomorrow. (present subjunctive)
