

## Simple Past: Irregular Verbs

**FORM:** There is no form for irregular verbs in the past tense. They must be memorized.

**USE:** To use the “**past tense**”, the time you are talking about must be finished.

**EXAMPLES:** We went to the casino last night. We were in class yesterday.
