Simple Past: Irregular Verbs

FORM: There is no form for irregular verbs in the past tense. They must be

memorized.

USE: To use the "past tense", the time you are talking about must be finished.

EXAMPLES: We <u>went</u> to the casino last night. We <u>were</u> in class yesterday.
