Simple Past: Interrogative Form FORM: All verbs, except the verb "to be", form the past tense questions by using "do" (past) followed by the subject followed by the simple form of the verb. "Do" (past) + subject + simple form Affirmative Interrogative I drank Did I drink...? You drank Did you drink...? Did she drink...? She drank Did he drink...? He drank It drank Did it drink...? We drank Did we drink...? You drank Did you drink...? Did they drink...? They drank USE: There are four ways to answer a yes/no question about the past. The long affirmative Did John buy a house? Yes, he bought a house on Park Avenue. The **short** affirmative Did John buy a house? Yes, he did. It's on Park Avenue. The long negative Did John buy a house? No, he didn't buy a house. He bought a boat. The **short** negative Did John buy a house? No, he didn't. He bought a boat. Note: When you answer a question in English, it is polite to add some more information as in the examples above.
