Continuous Tenses: Present, with While

FORM:

Subject + present progressive + while + subject + present progressive

USE:

The "Present Progressive" describes actions which are continuing in the present

(now).

"While" tells us that two verbs are happening at the same time.

EXAMPLES:

Listen! He is singing while he is taking a shower! I am listening to the radio while I'm shaving.
