

## Continuous Tenses: Present, with While

**FORM:**

**Subject + present progressive + while + subject + present progressive**

**USE:**

The “**Present Progressive**” describes actions which are continuing in the present (now).

“**While**” tells us that two verbs are happening at the same time.

**EXAMPLES:**

*Listen! He is singing **while** he is taking a shower!*

*I am listening to the radio **while** I 'm shaving.*
