Continuous Tenses: Past

FORM:

Example: (walk)
I was walking
You were walking
She was walking

She was walking He was walking It was walking We were walking You were walking They were walking The "past progressive" is formed by the past tense of "to be" (was/were) and (-ing) of the main verb.

USE:

The "continuous"/ "progressive" (both names are used) describes an action which is not finished, or was continuing, at a specific time. It can also be combined with another action introduced by words like "when" or "while".

EXAMPLES:

I was drinking a coffee at 8:00 a.m.

I was sleeping like a baby when the alarm clock rang this morning.

You were working, while she was sleeping.
