Interrogative: **Will + subject + base verb?**

Short Answers: **Yes + subject + will**

No + subject + will + not

Long Answers: **Yes + subject + will + base verb**

No + subject + will + not + base verb

The verb after **will** is always in the base verb form. It is never conjugated.

USE:

To ask about future probabilities.

E.g. **Will** you **go** on vacation next year?

I **will probably go** to Australia next winter.

EXAMPLES:

Will you finish your project by the end of the day?

Yes, I will.

No, I won't.
