Interrogative: Will + subject + base verb?

Short Answers: **Yes** + **subject** + **will**

No + subject + will + not

Long Answers: Yes + subject + will + base verb

No + subject + will + not + base verb

The verb after will is <u>always</u> in the base verb form. It is <u>never conjugated</u>.

USE: To ask about future probabilities.

E.g. Will you go on vacation next year?

I will probably go to Australia next winter.

EXAMPLES: Will you finish your project by the end of the day?

Yes, I <u>will.</u> No, I <u>won't.</u>
