Interrogative Form: **Be** (am, is, are) + subject + going to + base verb?

Short Answers: Yes + subject + be (am, is, are)

No + subject + be (am, is, are) + not

Long Answers: Yes + subject + be (am, is, are) + going to + base verb

No + subject + be (am, is, are) + not + going to + base verb

The verb <u>after</u> "going to" is always <u>a base verb</u>; it is <u>never</u> conjugated.

USE: To ask about future plans which were made before the time of speaking.

> e.g. Are you going to watch the hockey game at Shakey's Pub tonight? Yes, I am. I'm going to be there at 7:00 p.m.

EXAMPLES: <u>Are you going to go</u> to the concert on Saturday night?

No, I'm not.
