

# Prepositions: Beside, Between

**FORM:**

**BESIDE      BETWEEN**

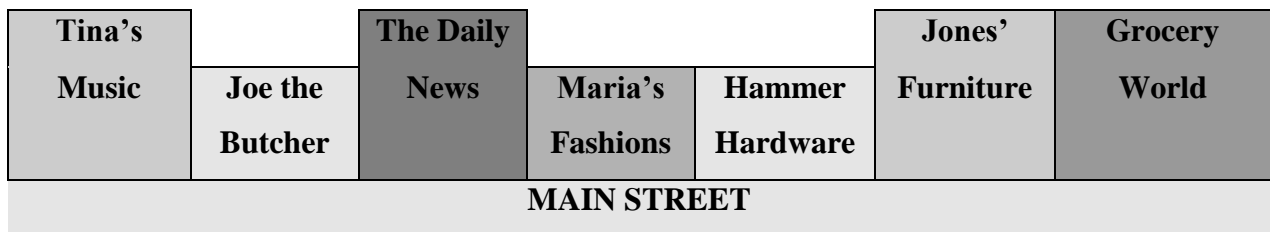
**USE:**

**“Beside”** means next to or on the left or right of someone or something.  
**“Between”** means in the middle of “this” and “that”.

**EXAMPLES:**

*A - B: “A” is beside “B” OR “B” is beside “A”.*  
*A-B-C: “B” is between “A” and “C”.*
