FORM:

BESIDE BETWEEN

USE: "Beside" means next to or on the left or right of someone or something.

"Between" means in the middle of "this" and "that".

EXAMPLES: A - B: "A" is beside "B" OR "B" is beside "A".

A-B-C: "B" is between "A" and "C".
