FORM:	I have to go We have to go You have to go You have to go She has to go They have to go He has to go It has to go	
USE:	Use "have to" plus the un-conjugated verb to show that something is important, very important, necessary, obligatory or that it must be true. NOTE: "Have" is conjugated here according to the regular verb rules. The main verb is always in the base (un-conjugated) form.	
EXAMPLES:	I <u>have to go</u> home now. You <u>have to pay</u> your phone bill. You <u>have to arrive</u> on time at work. This is crazy. He <u>has to be</u> an idiot to do this!
