Relativ	ve Pronouns: Who, Which, That, Whom
FORM:	WHO WHICH WHOM THAT
	"Who", "which", "whom" and "that" are relative pronouns. They refer to a noun or pronoun which precedes them. They are used to join two clauses. (A "clause" is a noun + a verb.) The clause that starts with the relative pronoun is called a relative clause .
	I have a brother. He is studying in university. I have a brother <u>who</u> is studying in university.
USE:	"Who" is used when referring to people in the subject position of the sentence. <i>The lady <u>who</u> gave me directions was really nice.</i>
	"Whom" is used in formal English to replace a person in the object position. <i>I like the teacher. That is the teacher.</i> <i>That is the teacher</i> <u>whom</u> <i>I like.</i>
	"Which" is used when referring to things. <i>The restaurant which has great sushi is just around the corner.</i>
	"That" can be used for both people and things. The lady that gave me directions was really nice. The restaurant that has great sushi is just around the corner.
	Note: In clauses when you usually have to put commas (,) because of further information, you cannot use " that ". You have to use " who " for people and " which " for things. <i>My sister, <u>who</u> is 18, will be going to college next year.</i>
	 Whom and Which after prepositions: <u>Who</u> am I speaking <u>to</u>? <u>To whom</u> am I speaking? <u>Who</u> are you going <u>with</u>? <u>With whom</u> are you going? That is the restaurant <u>in which</u> I met my husband.
