## **Comparing and Contrasting: Overview**

**FORM:** Review: Expressing Differences

	Comparative	Superlative
One syllable	Usually add: $-er + than$	Usually add: the + -est
Two syllables ending in –y or -ow	Usually add: -er + than	Usually add: the + -est
Two or more	Usually add:	Usually add:

<u>Irregular Forms:</u> good better than the best bad worse than the worst far farther than the farthest

Notes: 1. If a one-syllable adjective ends in a single vowel followed by a single consonant, usually double the final consonant and add *-er* or *-est*. (*big-bigger-biggest*)

2. If an adjective ends in -y, change the -y to -I

**USE:** Comparatives: To show differences between two people, places or things.

**Superlatives**: To show differences between three or more people, places or things. Superlatives show extremes of difference (the top or bottom of a group)

**EXAMPLES:** Cars are <u>faster than</u> bicycles. (Comparative)

*Planes are the fastest method of transportation. (Superlative)* 

**FORM:** Expressing Similarities

as + adjective + as

**USE:** To express similarities between people, places or things.

**EXAMPLES:** *Ken is as tall as Frank. (they are the same height)* 

Lions are <u>as dangerous as</u> tigers. (they are equally dangerous)
