Possession: The Determiner "Own"

FORM:

possessive noun + own (Fay's own ...)
possessive determiner + own (her own ...)
on + possessive determiner + own (on her own ...)

USE:

Following possessive nouns or possessive determiners, e.g. David's, his, etc., "own" acts to intensify the idea that something belongs to someone. "On + possessive determiner + own" means that someone or some people are alone or are doing compathing alone.

or are doing something alone.

EXAMPLES:

Susan will drive <u>her own</u> car to Richmond.

This is <u>Steve's own</u> computer - it's not the company's.

Sally wrote this report on her own.
