## The Infinitive: Following Adjectives and Past Participles

FORM:

ADJECTIVE OR PAST PARTICIPLE + INFINITIVE

**USE:** This structure first tells us about the quality of a person or persons in one

situation, and then tells us what the situation is, was or will be.

**EXAMPLES:** *My wife will be thrilled to learn that I've won the lottery.* 

The students were <u>fascinated to hear</u> about her trip up the Amazon.

We were sad to see our old friends leave.
