Comparatives and Superlatives: Verbs Verb Comparative Superlative FORM: weigh weigh more than weigh the most weigh less than weigh the least eats the most eats eats more than eats less than eats the least **USE:** Verbs can also be used with comparatives and superlatives. The verb can be in any tense, and is always placed before the comparative or superlative. For comparatives, use **VERB** + **MORE/LESS** THAN and for superlatives use VERB + THE MOST/LEAST. **EXAMPLES:** A cow weighs more than a dog. An elephant weighs the most. Gold costs more than silver. Platinum costs the most.
