

## Tag Questions: To Be in The Past

### FORM:

I was..., wasn't I?  
You were..., weren't you?  
She was..., wasn't she?  
He was..., wasn't he?  
It was..., wasn't it?  
We were..., weren't we?  
You were..., weren't you?  
They were..., weren't they?

I wasn't..., was I?  
You weren't..., were you?  
She wasn't..., was she?  
He wasn't..., was he?  
It wasn't..., was it?  
We weren't..., were we?  
You weren't..., were you?  
They weren't..., were they?

### USE:

The “**tag question**” is used to confirm things, to check that something is true or to confirm that someone agrees with you. Please note that in the tag ending the pronouns are used exclusively; no nouns can be used.

**NOTE:** **There was...wasn't there?** and **There were...weren't there?** are both common structures when used with “to be”.

**EXAMPLES:** *The mayor was wrong about the deficit, wasn't he?*  
*He wasn't right about the deficit, was he?*
