FORM:	Person + would or "-'d" rather + base verb				
USE:	"Would rather" demonstrates a preference. When you use it to describe something you want to do, the following verb is in the base form. In comparisons than is used. Please note that after than <u>the infinitive (minus the to)</u> is used.				
EXAMPLE:	I' <u>d rather move</u> to the suburbs <u>than stay</u> in the city.
