

Expressing Preferences: Would Rather

FORM:

Person + would or “-’d” rather + base verb...

USE:

“**Would rather**” demonstrates a preference. When you use it to describe something you want to do, the following verb is in the base form. In comparisons **than** is used. Please note that after **than** the infinitive (minus the to) is used.

EXAMPLE:

I’d rather move to the suburbs than stay in the city.
