## **Expressing Preferences: Prefer**

**FORM:** 

Also: so + pronoun + prefer + noun + to + noun

**USE:** 

**"Prefer"** can be followed immediately by the "thing" you prefer. If you want to mention the thing you do not prefer, place the preposition "**to**" after the first noun, and place the noun you do not prefer immediately after "**to**" to demonstrate what you or other people like better. It is an alternative to "**would rather + base verb**".

One can also **use "so"** to show preference *I prefer* rice. *I prefer rice to potatoes*.

Maria loves Chinese food, so she prefers rice to potatoes.
