

## Wh-Questions: What + Be

**FORM:**

**What + be + noun or adjective or preposition...?**  
**What + noun + be + ...?**

**USE:**

“**What**” asks questions about nouns – people or things. When we ask a question with “what”, there are three possible answers:

**What** is loud?

The radio is loud.

The radio is.

The radio.

**What** colour is her new car?

Her new car is black.

It's black.

Black.

**EXAMPLES:**

*What is your name?*



*My name is Maria.*

*The agenda is on the table.*



***What** is on the table?*
