## Possessive Form: Adjectives

USE: Possessive Adjectives show belonging. They demonstrate that someone or something has something. A noun always follows a possessive adjective. Possessive adjectives agree with the noun they replace. They also have the same form before singular and plural nouns.
E.g. Carol is from Colorado. Her husband is from Venezuela.

EXAMPLES: You are next to me. Your seat is here.
We are businessmen. Our stores are all over the country. That is Bill and Mary's house. That is their house.
