Present Continuous: Affirmative Form

FORM:

I am You are He is She is It is We are You are They are	(I'm) (You're) (He's) (She's) (It's) (We're) (You're) (They're)	working.
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subject + be (am, is, are) + verb + "-ing"

USE:

The **Present Continuous** is also called the Present Progressive. Use the contracted form in speaking and in informal writing.

The present continuous is used:

• to talk about an action that is happening <u>right now</u>; an action in progress. The following time expressions are often used with the present continuous:

> now right now at the moment today at present

e.g. Mark is talking to his girlfriend right now.

• to talk about an action that is temporary.

e.g. Michele is taking care of the children today.

EXAMPLES: *I am reading my exercises at the moment.*
